#### 1. Knowledge

- 1.1** Appropriate theoretical technical knowledge and practical experience of ships and their operation and the provisions of the relevant national and national instruments necessary to perform duties as appointed surveyors.

- 1.4** Understanding of the processes both on board and ashore processes, internal as well as external possession of professional competency to perform necessary tasks effectively and efficiently.
- 1.5** Full safety awareness in all circumstances, also for one's own safety and training/experience in tasks to be performed and preferably also in functions to be assessed.

#### 2. Qualifications

An appointed ship surveyor is required to have:

- 2.1** Either an appropriate qualification from a marine or nautical institution and relevant seagoing experience as a certified ship officer holding or having held a valid STCW II/2 III/2 certificate of competency and have maintained their technical knowledge of ships and their operation since gaining their certificate of competency; and served for a period of not less than three years at sea as an officer in the deck or engine department, or
- 2.2** A relevant university degree from a tertiary institution as a naval architect, mechanical engineer or an engineer related to the maritime fields and worked in that capacity for at least five years.
- NOTE: A copy of the relevant qualification, degree or certificate of competency is to be submitted.**



**3.0. Surveying Experience**

**3.1** Preceding appointment, relevant experience for at least three years on ships of more than 24meters in length provided that where appointment is restricted to ships of under 24meters in length this period shall be at least one year on ships of more than 6 metres in length.

**NOTE: Relevant testimonials and supporting documentation to be included as applicable.**
