Laying of Temporary pontoons along the Main Breakwater in Mgarr Harbour, Gozo

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that 50 meters of pontoons will be laid along the main breakwater in Mgarr, Gozo, as shown on the attached chart.

The laying of the pontoons will be carried out from a flat barge with the assistance of divers. The works are due to start on Friday 6th March 2020. The works will take place during dark hours between 2100hrs and 0400hrs of the following day.

Owners of vessels that are moored or have a mooring within the area are to remove such moorings and associated ground tackle. They are to remove them immediately. Any vessels and moorings that are left in this area after Friday 6th March 2020 will be removed at the expense of the owner. No liability whatsoever will be accepted by the Authority for any damage that may be caused while removing the said vessels and moorings.

In view of the above a wide berth is to be given to the main breakwater. Vessels are to navigate at very slow speed and with no wake.

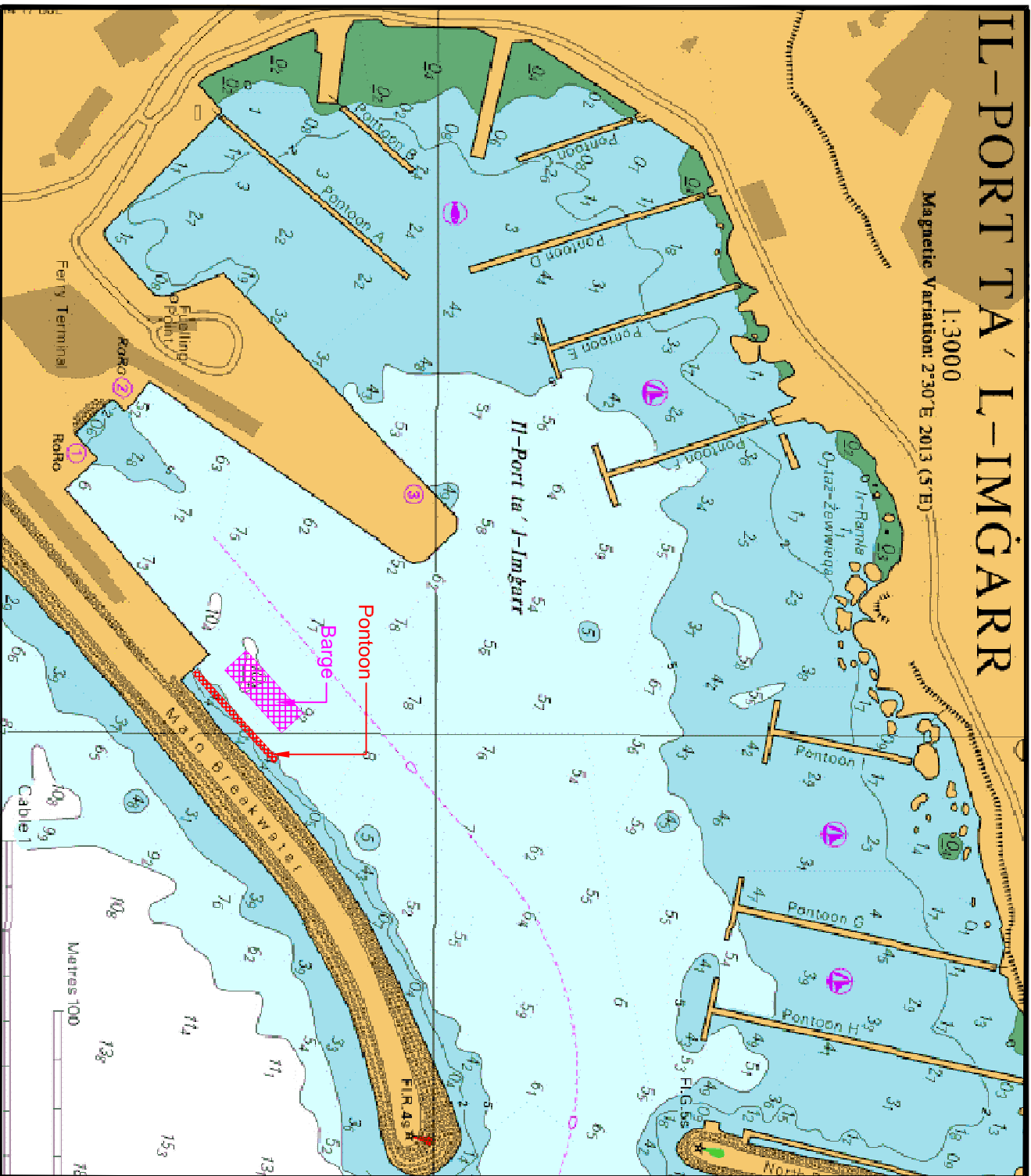
Mariners are to obey any instructions issued by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF channel 12 and by Enforcement Officers on site.
