### Re-installation of floating pontoons in Il-Magħluq, Il-Port ta' Marsaxlokk

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that floating pontoons will be re-installed at Il-Magħluq, Il-Port ta' Marsaxlokk.

The preparation and re-installation of the floating pontoons will take place between Friday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2020 and Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> November 2020.

The assembling and re-installation of the pontoons will be carried out by scuba divers and will be accompanied by the support vessels "MV Gold Dredger", "MV Goldfinder" and "Anselma", and they will be displaying the international code of Signals flag "A".

Due to the re-installation, the area A, B, C, D and E (as shown hatched on attached chart) will be used as a working area, therefore this is a **restricted** area for the duration of the works.

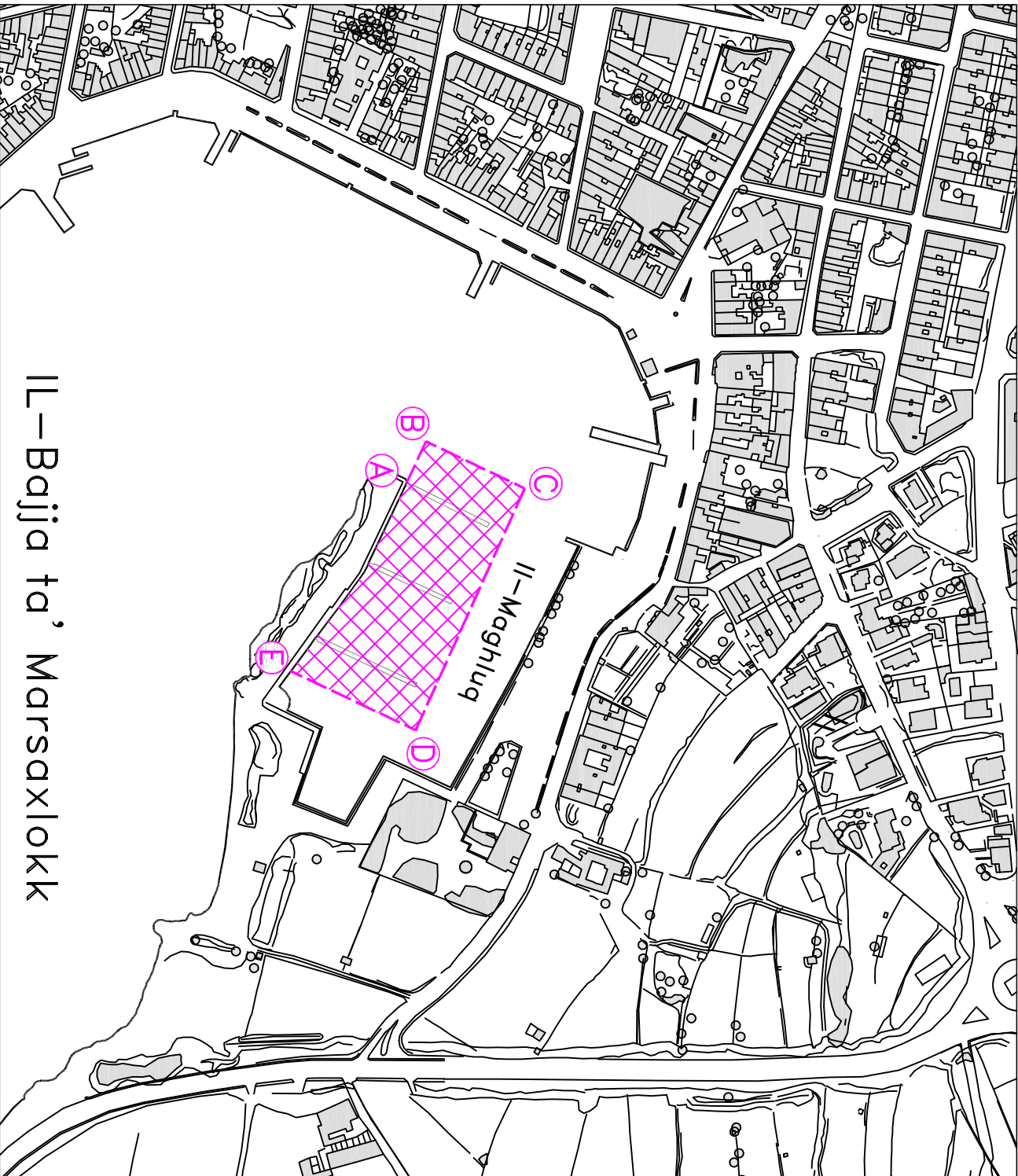

Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp lookout, navigate with caution and slow speed (no wake) when navigating close to the above indicated area.

They are to cooperate with the contractor on site and comply with any instructions given by Marsaxlokk Port Control (Marsaxlokk VTS) on VHF Channel 14.
