Transportation of Statue from II-Port il-Kbir to Birzebbugia by vessel - 2022

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, would like to notify mariners that on Friday 5th August 2022, a Statue of St. Peter will be loaded onto a vessel from Barriera Wharf in II-Port il-Kbir (point A as shown on the attached chart) and transported from there to a location close to the Birzebbugia water polo pitch in II-Port ta' Marsaxlokk (point B as shown on the attached chart).


The ceremony will start at 1800 hours and is expected to be completed by 2000 hours.

During the trip, several other vessels are expected to accompany the vessel carrying the statue.

Mariners are to navigate with caution at slow speed and to keep a sharp lookout when in the vicinity to the above-mentioned vessels and when sighted they are to give the vessel carrying the statue a wide berth.

They are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and on VHF Channel 14 and/or 16, by Marsaxlokk VTS and the organisers.
