Fireworks Display from Manoel Island - Feast of Stella Maris - Sliema

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta notifies Mariners that fireworks will be let off from the foreshore of Manoel Island in Sliema Creek, centred on points A and B as shown on the attached chart:

The fireworks display will take place as follows:

Tuesday 16 th August 2022	between 0900 hours and 0910 hours, between 1200 hours and 1210 hours and between 1915 hours and 1945 hours.
Friday 19 th August 2022	between 0900 hours and 0910 hours. between 1200 hours and 1210 hours and between 2215 hours and 2300 hours.
Saturday 20 th August 2022	between 0900 hours and 0930 hours, between 1200 hours and 1220 hours, between 1800 hours and 1900 hours and between 2130 hours and 2330 hours.
Sunday 21 st August 2022	between 0900 hours and 0910 hours, between 1200 hours and 1210 hours and between 1930 hours and 2300 hours.










There will also be a display of ground fireworks on the Sliema side which will be held on Saturday 20th August 2022 between 2330 hours and 0130 hours Sunday morning.

In view of the above, mariners are informed that navigation within 200 meters from the above-mentioned positions, point A and point B and 60 meters from point C, as shown on the attached chart, in Marsamxett Harbour will be prohibited during the date and times of the firework displays as mentioned above. All craft moored within the indicated areas (as shown on the attached chart) are to be removed on the above-mentioned date and times of the firework displays.

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta will accept no liabilities whatsoever for any vessels that are left lying in the area on the above-mentioned date and times

Mariners are to obey instructions and directions given on VHF channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS and any Enforcement Officials in the area.
