Fire curtain display - Festa Madonna ta' Fatima (Pieta)

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, hereby notifies mariners that a Fire curtain display will be held in Id-Daħla tal-Pieta, on Saturday 1st June 2024, starting at 2255 hours for a period not exceeding 5 minutes. The display will be held within the area formed by joining the points 1, 2, 3, 4 and the intermediate coastline (as shown on the attached chart) in the approximate following position:

2	35° 53'.590	014° 29'.861
3	35° 53'.581	014° 29'.859
4	35° 53'.584	014° 29'.822

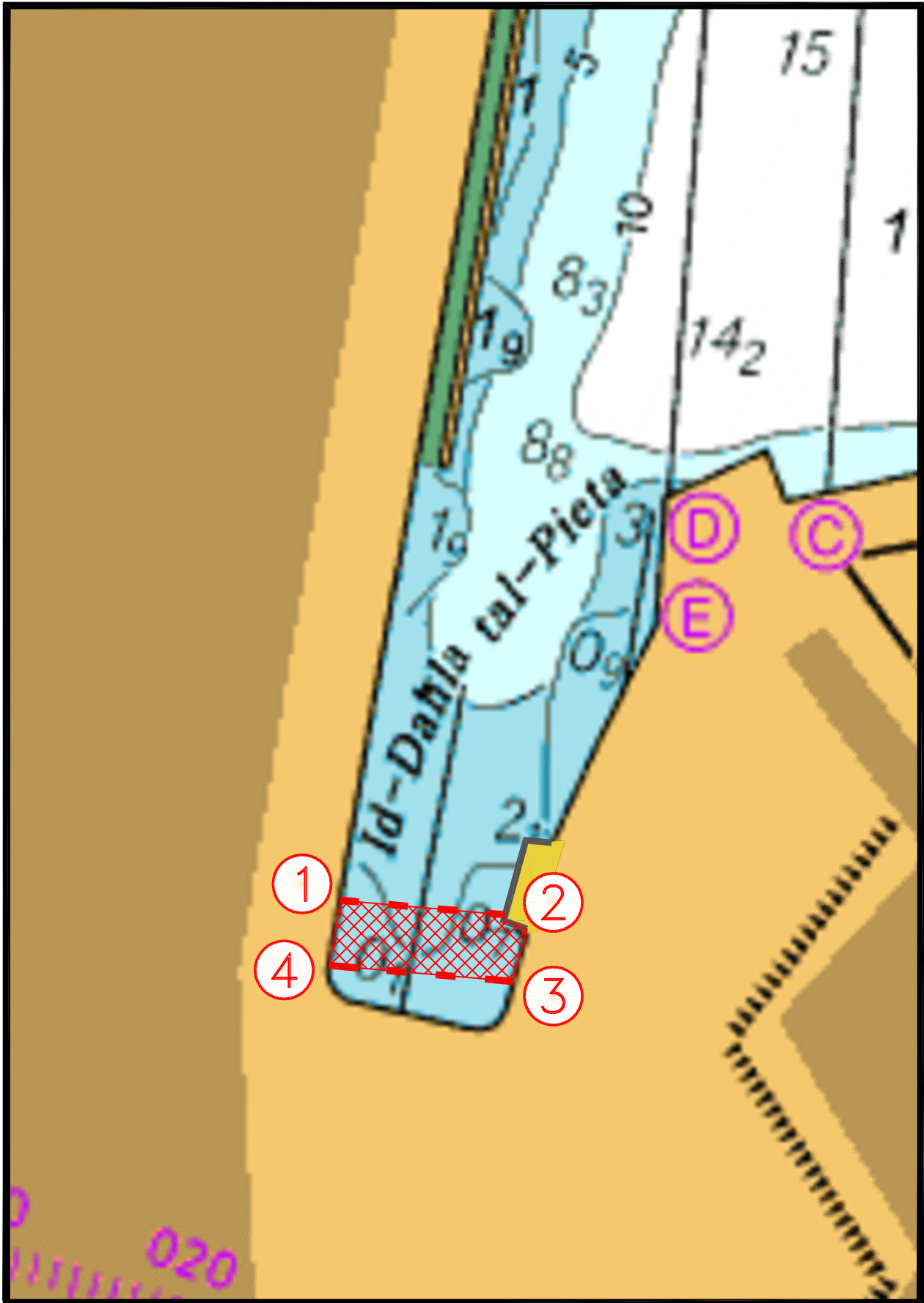
In view of the above, mariners are advised to keep a safe distance from the area on the above-mentioned date and time.

Any boats berthed or moored within the above-mentioned area, are to be removed during the above-mentioned date and time.

Transport Malta will accept no liability whatsoever for any damage caused by the displays to any mooring pontoon or vessel and their ancillary equipment, whether such mooring pontoon or vessel and their ancillary equipment are left within the safety zone, or outside such safety zone.

All mariners are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and by any Enforcement Officers on site.
