Fireworks Display - Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel - Valletta

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that fireworks display in connection with the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel will be let off from points A and B on Manoel Island (as shown on the attached chart) on the following date and times: -

POSITION	LATITUDE (N)	LONGITUDE (E)
A	35° 54'.145	014° 30'.356
B	35° 54'.246	014° 30'.260

Monday 15th July 2024 from 1145 hours until 1200 hours,
from 1830 hours until 1900 hours,
from 2230 hours until 2300 hours and
from 2245 hours until 2315 hours.

Tuesday 16th July 2024 from 0800 hours until 0815 hours,
from 1200 hours until 1215 hours,
from 1900 hours until 1930 hours and
from 2100 hours until 2130 hours.

Mariners are to keep a safe distance of at least 200 metres from the position indicated.

Any boats berthed or anchored within the area shown on the attached chart are to be removed during the above-mentioned dates and times.

Transport Malta will accept no liability whatsoever for any damage caused by the firework displays to any vessel and her ancillary equipment, whether such vessel and her ancillary equipment are left within the 200m safety zone, or outside such safety zone, from the point from which the fireworks are let off.

All mariners are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS, while entering and navigating between Marsamxett Harbour and Grand Harbour.
