Removal and reconstruction of road bridge at Il-Fossa in Il-Port ta' Marsamxett

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and the general public that the removal and reconstruction of the road bridge leading to the boat chamber at Il-Fossa in Il-Port ta' Marsamxett, will be carried out.

The works will commence on Monday 15th July 2024 and are expected to be completed by Wednesday 31st July 2024.

A work area formed by the imaginary lines joining the points A, B, C and D and the inside the chamber, as shown in red on the attached chart, will be established.

A silt curtain will be laid within the above-mentioned area depending on where work is being carried out.

Mariners are to note that due to these works passage in and out of the boat chamber will be restricted and no diving/swimming will be allowed within the area throughout the duration of the works.

The works will be carried out mostly from land. Scuba divers who will be assisting in the works, will be displaying the International Code of Signals flag "A".

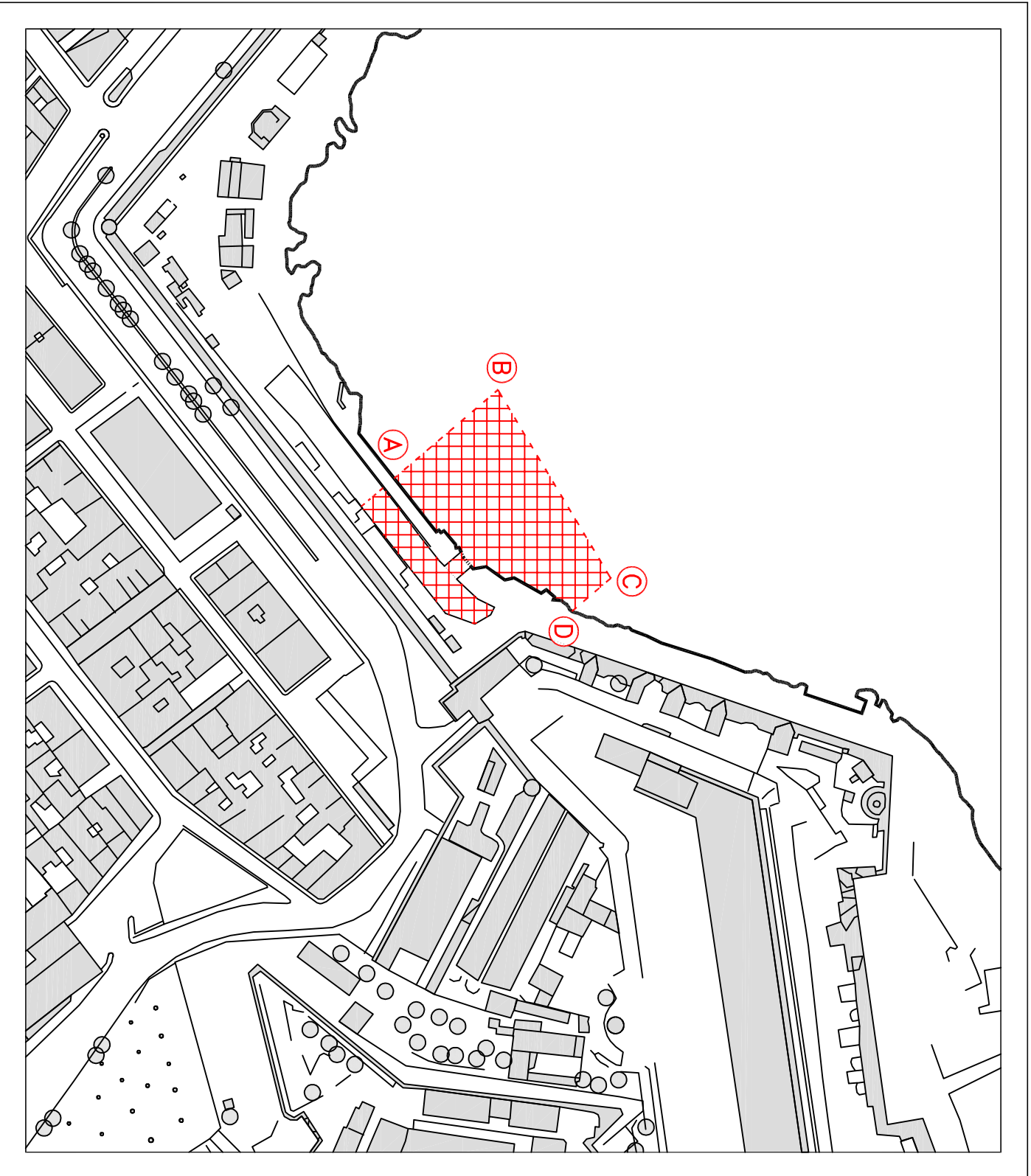
Mariners and vessel operators are to navigate with caution and at slow speed (no wake) when in the vicinity. They are to co-operate with the contractor on site.



Mariners are to comply with instructions issued on VHF channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS.
