Transportation of Statue in Grand Harbour by vessel – 14th July 2024

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, would like to notify mariners that on Sunday 14th July 2024, a Statue of St. Joseph will be loaded on a vessel from Marsa – ‘Il-Moll tal- Pont’ (point A on attached chart) and transported to Kalkara – ‘Il-Ponta ta’ Bighi (point B on attached chart),

The ceremony will commence at 1700 hours and is expected to be completed by 1800 hours.

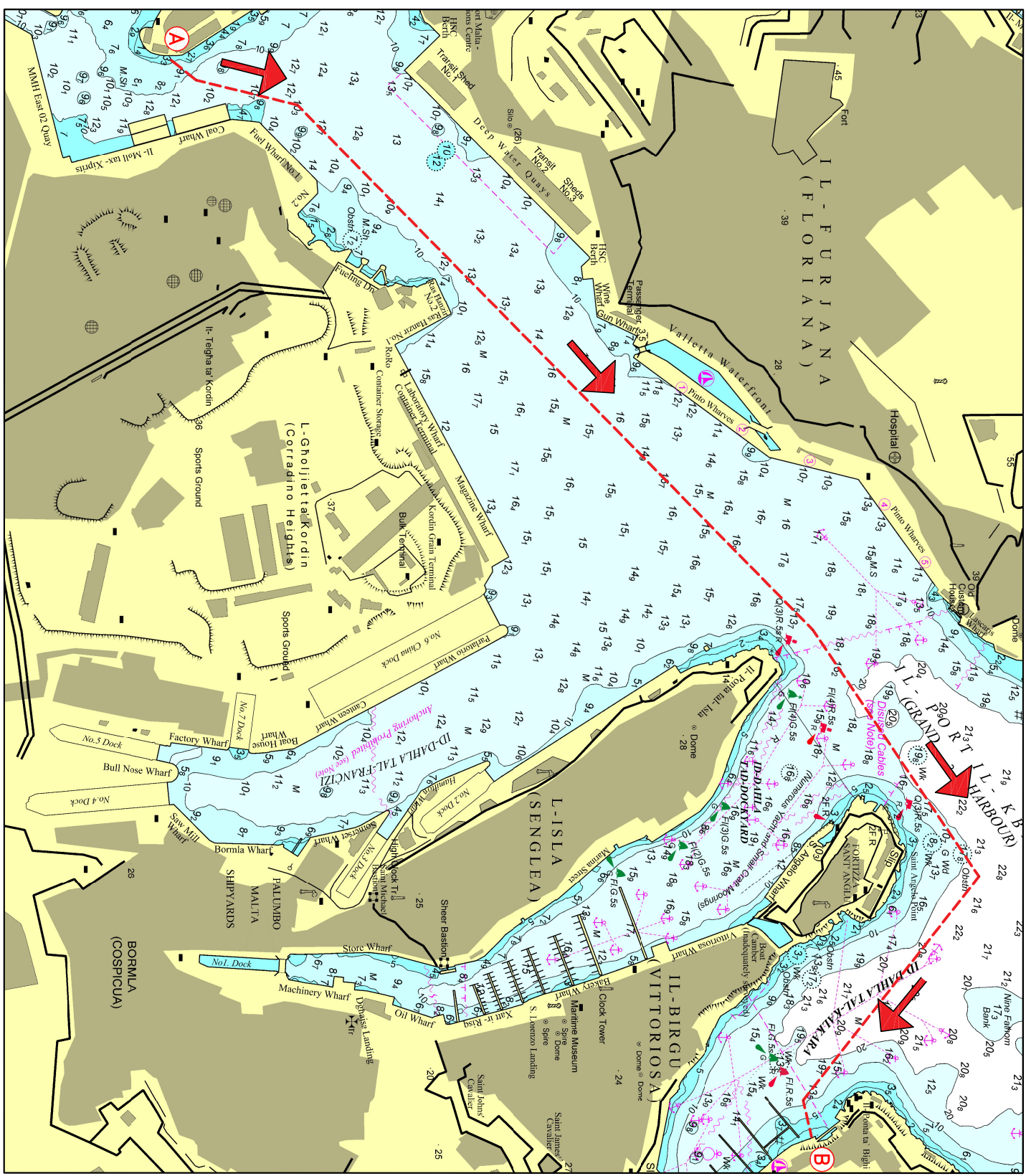
During the trip, several other vessels are expected to accompany the vessel carrying the statue.

The transportation of the statue shall take place when no vessel traffic is scheduled to enter or depart from the Grand Harbour – Il-Port il-Kbir.

Mariners are to navigate with caution at slow speed and to keep a sharp lookout when in the vicinity to the above-mentioned events and when sighted they are to give the vessel carrying the statue a wide berth.

They are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and the organisers.
